

## 8. Report on the outreach programme to raise awareness about vector-borne diseases

(Date: 16.05.2019)

The one-day certificate programme on Thalasemia & Vector-borne diseases at PRTGC aims to prevent and control six vector borne diseases including malaria, Japanese encephalitis, dengue, chikungunya, kala-azar, and lymphatic filariasis. The programme was held at the Seminal Hall, Admin Building, WBSU Campus, Barasat. It uses a three-pronged strategy of disease management, integrated vector management, and behaviour change communication. Total Forty volunteers attended the programme and also learnt about malaria, its transmission, signs and symptoms, control strategies including the drug distribution centers and use of larvicides.
